



27TH INTERNATIONAL WORKSHOP ON NEUTRINOS FROM ACCELERATORS (NUFACT 2026)

August 31 - September 5, 2026 - Tsung-Dao Lee Institute, Shanghai (China)

Dear Colleagues,

We are excited to announce that the **27th International Workshop on Neutrinos from Accelerators** (NuFact 2026) will take place in Shanghai, China, from August 31 to September 5, 2026, at the Tsung-Dao Lee Institute (TDLI), Shanghai Jiao Tong University (SJTU).

NuFact 2026 is the 27th annual workshop focused on current and future neutrino projects based on accelerators and reactors, as well as muon physics. Originally started in 1999 to discuss "Neutrino Factories," it has since expanded to cover all accelerator- and reactor-based neutrino projects, as well as muon physics.

SCIENTIFIC PROGRAM

The workshop features invited plenary talks, parallel sessions, and joint working group discussions. The program is structured around seven Working Groups (WGs):

- WG1: Neutrino Oscillation Physics
- WG2: Neutrino Scattering Physics
- WG3: Accelerator Physics
- WG4: Muon Physics
- WG5: Neutrinos Beyond PMNS
- WG6: Detectors
- WG7: Inclusion, Diversity, Equity, Education, and Outreach (IDEEO)

The scientific program also features a poster session focused on contributions from young researchers. Flash talks will be chosen from the submitted posters.

Abstract submission opens on February 11, 2026, and closes on May 31, 2026, at 11:59 PM.

VENUE

The workshop will be held at the Tsung-Dao Lee Institute (TDLI) in Shanghai. TDLI is a research institute of Shanghai Jiao Tong University, established in 2016, that focuses on frontier scientific questions in physics and astronomy.

Tsung-Dao Lee Institute (TDLI) is located in the Pudong New Area of Shanghai and is easily accessible by air, train, and public transportation.

By plane

- PVG Airport: Airport Link (15 min) to Kangqiao East Station + taxi (8 min). Direct taxi: ~25 min.
- SHA Airport: Airport Link (25 min) to Kangqiao East Station + taxi (8 min). Direct taxi: ~45-60 min.

By train

From Hongqiao Railway Station, Shanghai Station, or Shanghai South Station, you can take the metro and transfer to Line 13 (Zhongke Road Station) or Line 2 (Jinke Road Station), then take a bus or taxi to the institute.

By public transport

- Airport Link: Kangqiao East Station is ~2.5 km away.
- Metro: 2 km from Zhongke Road Station (Line 13) & Jinke Road Station (Line 2).
- Taxi/Ride-hailing: Widely available (e.g., Didi via Alipay).
